The Future Perfect Tense

Past Perfect - This verb tense uses two actions at two different times. For colloquial English, we don't use past perfect continuous very often. Simple Future - This verb tense is about planning things to do in the future. . in daily expressions, books especially; stories and novels adopt the tense more.
