They offer autopropit raises to their opponents right and left, but very few actually seize the opportunity. If one player can play well for 8 hours and another can play well for 12 hours, the player who can play well for 12 hours will almost certainly win more money in the long run.

You should be doing this the majority of the time. Obviously don't play all night. Notice that by calling instead of reraising with most of your good, but not amazing, hands, such as A-J, K-Q, and Ts-9s, you get to see if you flop well before investing a significant amount of money. If you only pay attention when you are involved in a pot, you will fail to develop vital reads on your opponents, costing you a ton of equity whenever you enter a pot.

Consequently, checking at least one street oftentimes the flop is the best play. You are never going to get your opponent to fold by calling. Nate L Patience is what it's all .
